

RESOLUTION # 06-03

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE IMMOKALEE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT ADOPTING REVISED RATES FOR MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES; TO PROVIDE FOR A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the IMMOKALEE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") is empowered to construct, operate and maintain a Water and Sewer System (the "System") within the boundaries of the lands described in Florida Statute Chapter 98-495, and

WHEREAS, the Board is empowered to prescribe, fix, establish and collect fees, rentals or other charges for the use of the facilities and services furnished by said System, said fees to be fixed and revised from time to time so as to be sufficient at all times to provide for the expense of the operation, maintenance and repair of such System and to provide a margin of safety over and above the total amount of any such expenses and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE IMMOKALEE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, in public meeting assembled that:

1. This resolution amends and replaces the fees and charges that are in listed in Resolution 05-01; and
2. The miscellaneous charges as set forth in the Schedule attached hereto as Exhibit "A" will provide a mechanism for the District to redeem the costs that are incurred as a result of the listed services, and those fees and charges are hereby adopted; and
3. If any phase or portion of this Resolution is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion.
4. This resolution shall become effective on April 1, 2006.
